The American Romanian Academy of Arts and Sciences (ARA)^[1] [2] [3] [4] is an international academic research and educational institution that conducts and supports multidisciplinary studies in exact sciences, mathematics, natural sciences, and also supports the arts, linguistics, literature, political studies and sociology. As an institution its main goal is to foster cultural exchanges between the American and Romanian cultures^[5].

ARA sponsors conferences, annual congresses^[6] [7], organizes research projects, and publishes its own peer-reviewed international journal under the title "*Journal of the American Romanian Academy of Arts and Sciences*." [8] [9], as well as an ARA Newsletter for its membership^[10].



The Romanian branch of ARA^[11] has its center in Timishoara, Romania, that is closely coordinated with the US main organization. At present, ARA also enjoys the support of its scholarly activities by the Carol I National Defence University^[12].

Areas of interest

ARA is presently supporting specific research activities in the following areas:

1. Law. Politics. 2. Philosophy. Theology. 3. History. Anthropology. 4. Linguistics. Literature. 5. Economy. Environment. 6. Biology. Medicine. 7. Education 8. Physics and Chemistry. 9. Engineering. Applied Mathematics.

Educational activities

ARA also organizes educational courses at various times in specific areas such as, for example: Mathematics, Fluid Mechanics, Economics, Romanian and American History, Comparative History of Religions, Romanian Folklore and American Literature correlates, Aesthetics, Folk Dancing, Folklore Quilting and Paintings.

The engineering and computing courses organized in collaboration with the Romanian Branch of ARA in Timishoara are especially popular, and attracted large audiences of both students and faculty^[13].
